# Grade Seven

This is an abstinence based unit that will be taught by a Health and Physical Education Teacher who has been trained to provide information and answer questions about these topics. It will be their job to build upon the knowledge that the student has already learned from the previous grade. There will be presentations of factual and age appropriate information to students in gender separated classes.

## **OBJECTIVE**

7.1 The student will review the changes that occur during adolescence and learn how to adjust to these changes.

### CONTENT

- I. Adolescence/puberty definitions
- II. Strategies to adjust to the changes that occur during puberty
- III. Physical, social, emotional, and intellectual growth during adolescence

- 2. The use of a PowerPoint entitled, *Adolescence and Puberty,* and current materials will be used as resources for the above topics.
- 3. The use of recommended visual aid: Video You, Your Body, and Puberty.

## **OBJECTIVE**

7.2 The student will review male and female reproductive systems and discuss the process of reproduction through life stages.

#### CONTENT

- I. Review anatomy of the reproductive system
- II. Problems of the reproductive system
- III. Fertilization and development

## **OBJECTIVE**

7.3 The student will identify basic facts about communicable diseases and sexually transmitted infections, and will recognize one's responsibility for prevention of diseases.

#### CONTENT

- I. Communicable diseases
- II. The immune system
- III. Sexually transmitted infections and HIV/AIDS

- IV. Cause, symptoms, transmission, and prevention
- V. Abstinence

7.4 The student will recognize the importance of abstinence.

- III. Refusal skills
- IV. Benefits of postponing pregnancy until marriage
