Grade 3 (one 60 minute lesson)

- *Positive self-image characteristics and attributes
- *Correct terminology for body parts, including private body parts
- *Privacy of one's own body parts
- *Good touch, bad touch
- *How to identify inappropriate touches and confusing situations

Grade 4 (one 90 minute lesson)

- +Awareness of stranger danger and ways to stay safe
- +Awareness of and responding to various types of harassment
- +Awareness and strategies to prevent exploitation and abuse
- *Mental, emotional, and social needs
- *Physical and emotional changes associated with puberty
- *Reproductive anatomy and functions

Grade 5 (two 90 minute lessons)
